

MULTICULTURAL ARTS PROGRAM For Young People

What is it?

MAP (Multicultural Arts Program) is a contemporary arts access program for newly arrived young people to Australia.

Who is it for?

Refugee and migrant young people aged 15 - 25 who have been living in Australia for five years or less.

How does it work?

Young people with the support of project workers will attend a workshop program introducing them to contemporary visual, performing and dance arts disciplines.

The workshop dates are:

Saturday 6th February 2010, 11am to 4pm
Saturday 13th February 2010, 11am to 4pm
Saturday 20th February 2010, 11am to 4pm
Saturday 27th February 2010, 11am to 4pm

Where is it?

Workshops will take place at the Australian Centre of Contemporary Art (ACCA), Malthouse Theatre, Chunky Move, and St. Martins Youth Arts Centre.

The Multicultural Arts Program is FREE. Food and transport will be provided throughout the program.
