This CMY Facebook page is for people to find out more about the Centre for Multicultural Youth (CMY), the services we offer, as well as hosting debate and discussion about important issues for young people from migrant and refugee backgrounds. Please be respectful of all points of view, and refrain from personal attacks on other users. CMY will remove any posts which:

- are likely to be offensive to other readers
- is dogmatic, such as setting out courses of action as “the only way”
- is racist, sexist or discriminatory
- is obscene, or uses graphic sexual language
- is defamatory, or overly critical of services or organisations which provide help to others
- for any other reason is likely to cause harm / distress to young people
- is posted for commercial purposes
- promotes inaccurate, inappropriate or harmful advice.

CMY encourages community members to share information about events, support groups or other organisations but request information is only posted once to maintain a flow of discussion and ensure that no one event is given undue prominence. Multiple posts promoting a service, group or product will be removed.
