ENTRY RULES AND CONDITIONS

GENERAL INFORMATION

ENTRY FEE

An entry fee of **\$50.00** (including GST) per team must accompany the entry form. Teams will not be registered until payment is made. **Limited entries available, so entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis.**

VENUE, DATE, AND TIME

Venues, dates, and times vary for each region:

- 1) All Nations South Region Challenge** = Saturday July 7th from 9am – 5pm at Springers Leisure Centre, 400 Cheltenham Rd Keysborough.
- 2) All Nations North Region Challenge** = Sunday July 8th from 9am – 5pm at the Mill Park Basketball Stadium, Redleap Reserve, Mill Park.
- 3) All Nations East Region Challenge** = Sunday July 15th from 8am at Boroondara Sports Complex, 271C Belmore Road, Balwyn North
- 4) All Nations West Region Challenge** = Sunday July 22nd from 9am at Rec West Community Recreation Centre, Lily Street, Braybrook
- 5) All Nations Geelong Regional Challenge** = TBC

The Grand Finalists for each competition of each region will then face off in the All Nations Championships

FIXTURES

Will be available on the day of competition

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

Players may play in one team only. A team shall consist of no more than **10 players**. A participant's age is determined by their age as at the 31st December. Players may not be any older than the age category they are participating in as at 31st December.

TEAM UNIFORM

All team members must wear shin pads and have numbered shirts. Goalkeepers must wear a different coloured shirt from other team members and referees. Rubber soled shoes must be worn to ensure that no damage is done to the indoor courts.

ENTRIES DEADLINE

Entries close **5:00pm Friday 8th June 2007**

CONFIRMATION LETTER

A confirmation letter with team registration forms will be sent out on **Wednesday 13th June 2007**. If you do not receive this letter within five days of this date please contact Chris Arena at Football Federation Victoria. Any changes to entry details or team withdrawals must be made in

writing and faxed to Football Federation Victoria. In the event of a team withdrawing from the competition, FFV will refund the registration fee in full if at least one weeks notice is given prior to competition in your region. No refund will be issued if the team withdraws with less than one week notice.

All team members are advised to follow the rules of each centre or face severe penalties. Strictly no food or drink is to be brought onto or consumed on any of the indoor courts. Water drink bottles are permitted.
