How does it work?

What is it?

Multicultural Arts Immersion is a contemporary arts access program for newly arrived young people to Australia. In a unique collaborative partnership, the Australian Centre of Contemporary Art (ACCA), Malthouse Theatre, and Chunky Move, will combine their resources and unique perspectives on contemporary art in order to nurture and encourage the development of artists for the future.

The workshop program:

The workshop program will explore contemporary:

- visual arts
- dance
- theatre

They will work with practising professional artists and investigate these art forms. The main focus of each day is about making art inspired by the current exhibition at ACCA. The exhibition's themes and ideas will be used as a starting point to discuss, think about and produce work using three different artistic disciplines.

Who is it for?
