The "Juggling Expectations" Training is for workers supporting newly arrived refugee young people in the family context. It will focus on issues around family dynamics and conflict and how this relates to culturally and linguistically diverse young people. CLD youth frameworks and service delivery strategies will be explored. The session will focus on ways to engage refugee young people, their families and broader cultural communities.

Participant learning outcomes include:

- Explore changes to refugee families' relationships and dynamics
- Discuss strategies for working with young people in the family context
- Identify some causes of, and responses to, dynamics between generations in newly arrived families
- Work towards strengthening family relationships in service planning and delivery
