MY Education Awards 2017

Volunteer Tutor Award

Awarded to an individual recognised by an OSHLSP or their community to have provided volunteer commitment beyond expectations in out-of-school-hours learning support for refugee and migrant students and their families.

- Describe what makes this person's contribution beyond expectations (max 250 words)
- Describe the outcomes of the person's contribution (max 250 words)

1. The person's role and the time s/he has been in it
2. The age group s/he is supporting
3. Specific mention of good practice or innovative methods
4. How students have been impacted
5. Quotes from students about this nominee (if appropriate)

Outstanding Student Award

Primary School: Awarded to an individual primary school age child that has achieved significant improvements in his or her own learning outcomes and has made a positive contribution to others through participation and leadership at an OSHLSP.

Secondary School: Awarded to an individual secondary school age child or young person that has achieved significant improvements in his or her own learning outcomes and has made a positive contribution to others through participation and leadership at an OSHLSP.

- Describe the contribution of the individual and their achievements (max 250 words)
- Describe what makes this person's contribution and achievements significant (max 250 words)
- Describe the outcomes of the person's contribution (max 250 words)

Please include in your answers:

1. The student's age and time at the OSHLSP
2. The key attributes of this student, which have led you to nominate him/her
3. The specific contribution made to others
4. A quote or comment from the student him/herself if appropriate
