What is Shout Out?

Shout Out is a leadership program for young people from refugee and migrant backgrounds designed to enable young people to speak up for themselves and share their experiences and views on a range of topics with a variety of audiences.

A consistent message CMY hears from young people and the general community is the need for opportunities for young people to have a voice and speak for themselves. CMY wants young people to be understood, accurately represented and influential members of the community.

By training young people in public speaking and connecting them to speaking opportunities at a range of forums, Shout Out empowers and enables young people to be active citizens and actively promote positive perceptions of young people as respected citizens in their community.

What's involved?

The application process starts by filling out and submitting an online application form. Chosen applicants will be invited to participate in an interview, after which successful applicants will be notified.

The successful applicants will be invited to the Induction & Training program, and will need to complete a Working with Children Check (free for volunteers) and Police Check (costs covered by CMY).

Attending the training program is compulsory. The training sessions will cover topics such as public speaking & storytelling, leadership and influencing positive change and being a CMY Youth Volunteer including professionalism and self-care.

After completing the training, program participants will liaise with CMY and stakeholders to present at or facilitate sessions organised by CMY across Melbourne.

Plus, you will get to attend ongoing professional development and group catch ups with CMY Youth Volunteers!

What is Settle Smart?

Settle Smart involves young people with a settlement experience in Australia sharing information they would have liked to have known when they first arrived with other newly-arrived young people.

A team of Peer Educators have developed content and activities and have been going out to schools and delivering information sessions. The new Peer Educators will undertake training in leadership, facilitation and presentation skills before co-delivering at least two information sessions each to newly-arrived young people.

Sessions will be organized by CMY, and held at English language centres throughout Melbourne.

The Settle Smart information sessions cover a range of topics and have been designed by young volunteers from migrant and refugee backgrounds.
