## Providing a safe and supportive learning environment in homework clubs



Students from migrant and refugee backgrounds will have a wide range of prior learning experiences including broken or unsafe learning journeys. As tutors it is important to consider how to provide a safe and supportive learning environment for students and the following suggestions below can assist.

ACTIONS	HOW CAN YOU DO THIS?	
Be positive and praise effort	<ul> <li>Encourage and compliment student's achievements and attempts</li> <li>Focus on what they have done well</li> <li>Be accepting rather than judgmental</li> <li>Ask students about their interests and follow up on these</li> </ul>	
Be reliable and trustworthy	<ul> <li>Do what you say you will and follow through</li> <li>Meet your commitments</li> <li>Maintain confidentiality unless the student's safety and wellbeing are at risk</li> <li>Provide good role modelling</li> <li>Be available</li> </ul>	
Communicate respectfully	<ul> <li>Pronounce students' names correctly</li> <li>Use active listening techniques</li> <li>Model polite forms of body language</li> <li>Use inclusive body language</li> </ul>	
Ask relevant questions of students, but also respect their privacy	<ul> <li>Judge whether or not students want to share information</li> <li>Recognise students control whether to disclose personal stories</li> <li>Acknowledge students' feelings</li> <li>If students talk about stressful events, listen and respond in a supportive way</li> </ul>	
Provide opportunities for appropriate expression of difficulties	<ul> <li>Encourage students to ask questions, seek advice/help for problems</li> <li>Encourage creative expression through a range of mediums</li> </ul>
